

The following information has been sent by the Pipeline Coalition:

The PUC Commissioner Chairman definitely is at least looking at the public comments filed in the case. He noted that the PUC has received about 80 written public comments so far, and that all but a handful are negative. As he is human, they have to have some effect on him. So, **IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY, I WOULD URGE YOU TO FILE A WRITTEN COMMENT/LETTER WITH THE PUC SOMETIME BEFORE AUGUST 6TH** (the sooner the better, but make sure you put enough time into it to do a good job).
