## KEEP KIDS SAFE FROM GUN ACCIDENTS



Every day in the US, an average of 19 children either die or receive treatment for a gunshot wound (American Academy of Pediatrics, 2017). National surveys also estimate that 35% of households with a child have at least one firearm and 43% of those homes have a least one unlocked firearm.

New Hampshire law imposes criminal penalties on people who negligently store firearms, where minors could or do gain access to the firearm.
