

# LITTLE MONADNOCK - WIDOW GAGE LOOP

**Distances**

- 4.5 miles total for entire loop
- 1.0 mile along Little Monadnock Trail
- 1.5 miles along Metacomet Trail
- 0.5 mile along Widow Gage Rd.
- 1.5 miles along Rhododendron Rd.

Woods trails are marked with blazes, and portions of these trails cross private property.

Turn left (south) on Metacomet-Monadnock Trail  
 View of Gap Mountain and Monadnock Mt. 1/4 mile to north
