

**Town of Fitzwilliam
Historic District Commission
Meeting Minutes
July 18, 2019**

Members Present: John Fitzwilliam, Chairman; Bill Davis, Marcia Camden and Claire Borowski, Members.

Others Present: Joseph Piccolo, Applicant; and Laurie Hayward, Land Use Administrative Assistant (LUA).

Call To Order The Chairman opened the meeting at 4:00.

The Chairman explained that this is a Special Meeting called to review an application for a Historic District Commission Permit for:

Joseph Piccolo regarding installing rooftop mounted solar tiles at 41 NH Rte. 119 West, which is in the Historic District, Tax Map 32, Lot 45.

Davis asked which house and Piccolo responded that it is the house between the Old Post Office and what was Beckett's Books.

The basics of the proposal had been discussed in the previous meeting held July 11, 2019, and they understand that there is an installation deadline. Davis asked for confirmation that the panels are on the rear of the house. Piccolo stated that the roof-top panels will be installed at the rear of the house. Board Members agreed that they were ready to approve the week before but did not have an application and they remain in favor of approval. Fitzwilliam stated that this does not affect the historic nature of the neighborhood and called for a motion.

Camden moved and Borowski seconded the motion to approve the Historic District Permit for Joseph Piccolo to install roof-top solar panels.

The LUA explained to the Applicant that he still needs approval of the Construction Permit which has been held pending Historic District Commission approval. The next time the Construction Permit can be approved is on Wednesday, July 24th at 7 PM, when the Board of Selectmen meet.

The Chairman signed the Historic District Permit.

There being no further business, **Fitzwilliam moved, the motion was seconded and approved unanimously that the meeting be adjourned** at 4:21.
