RE: Quarry Parking Issues

Residents of Fitzwilliam,

The warmer temperatures this week brought many folks to Fitzwilliam to cool off and with that parking issues.

It was brought to our attention that vehicles were congregating on Webb Hill Road and this was immediately handled. Shortly after, a resident stopped by the Police Department to complain about vehicles blocking the front of the Fire Department that could prevent emergency vehicles from exiting and entering. An officer immediately assessed the situation and did not discover any vehicles blocking access to the front of the building. It should be noted that all of the youth, whom the Police directly interacted with were respectful and immediately complied with Officer's instructions. No littering was observed or debris left behind.

The use of private property is not governed by the Fitzwilliam Police Department. The only person that has standing to restrict access is the property owner. The same property owner has a right to give permission to whomever they choose to use said property.

Webb Hill Road is posted 'No Parking' and monitored by Police.

There is limited parking at the Fire Association depot building and this too is monitored for violators. Double parking which could prevent access to the Fire Station is monitored and appropriate action would be taken if necessary.

'Parking for Official Business Only' signs have been ordered and will be posted at the Public Safety building, which will of course be monitored by Police.

Fitzwilliam has many great trails to wander and places to cool off on a hot day, which brings travelers to our quaint town. With travel, brings revenue and great interactions. Please know that your Police Department is handling all issues while trying to not discourage the positive effects of people enjoying their day in Fitzwilliam.
