Call to Order: 7:05 PM

Without a quorum, the Board reviewed materials in the board packet and discussed the Board's letter responding to Eversource attorney Allwarden's letter questioning the Board's consideration of the Eversource Q166 project in conjunction with the proposed pipeline. The Board's draft letter will be vetted by Attorney Cunningham prior to sending.

Landy wondered if Eversource had considered tree plantings in the wetlands on the north side of the PSNH/Eversource substation, suggesting black spruce as a tree that "likes wet feet."

Carney reported that Kinder Morgan was on Fullam Hill Road and apparently placed a plastic marker of some sort. She also said two pipeline abutting property owners had been contacted by Kinder Morgan and both refused access to their property.

The Board discussed scenic designation for certain areas in town, and Silverman noted the town has a history with scenic roads. They briefly discussed researching areas and roads in town that may need protection as scenic places to add to the Master Plan.

The Board adjourned at 7:45 PM.
