

FITZWILLIAM RECREATION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY DECEMBER 10, 2018

MEMBERS PRESENT: Sheena Royce, Christi Filipi, Bonnie Jones, Bruce Lafond, Catie Bisson, Bill Brown, and Cindi Beede.

The meeting convened at 7:00pm.

1. Basketball: Registration for the 2019 Fitzwilliam Youth Basketball Program was held prior to the Commission meeting. Just under thirty kids were signed up to participate. More are expected to register within the next few days. Program planning is underway and off to a good start.
2. Kid's Yoga: Robyn Andersen plans to instruct Yoga for kids ages 2-4 at the Fitzwilliam Town Library on Wednesday mornings (9:30-10:00am) beginning January 2nd. The session is planned for 6 weeks and will therefore run through February 6th. There is no charge or registration to participate.
3. Strong: Sheena Royce wants to possibly offer another session of Strong starting in March. She will be in contact with Mrs. Beede concerning this matter.
4. C/I/T: Danielle Jacques had to step down as lead for the playgroup, Caregivers/Infants/Toddlers and the position is currently open. Until it is filled, there are no sessions planned for the coming year. Ms. Bisson asked what the "Lead" is responsible for. Mrs. Beede explained that the "Lead" acts as a contact person for the playgroup, is responsible to getting the key from the Library the day before each playdate, and plans and instructs any craft or activity there may be. A request was posted on the Fitzwilliam Recreation Facebook page. There has been no inquiry as of yet.
5. Summer Rec: Mrs. Beede said she is planning to post an advertisement for the Summer Recreation Director position in the beginning of January. Kaitlyn Derry who held the position last summer, has notified Mrs. Beede that she will not be reapplying for the job due to other commitments.
6. Meadowood Task Force: Dorothy Zug is leading a Task Force to research the possible town acquisition of the former Meadowood property. The Task Force will meet on December 11th at the Fitzwilliam Town Hall. Ms. Bisson and Mrs. Beede will attend and answer questions regarding the Recreation Commission's involvement. Mrs. Royce is unsure if she will be able to attend.
7. Mr. Lafond announced his retirement from the Recreation Commission after many years of service. The Commission is very grateful for his input and help throughout his service. Mrs. Jones followed his announcement by stating she would be stepping down at the end of her appointment in February.

Mrs Filipi made a motion to adjourn at 8:00. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Royce and then passed 7-0.
