

RECREATION COMMISSION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

JANUARY 8, 2018

MEMBERS PRESENT: Bonnie Jones, Catie Bison, Bonnie Jones, Sheena Royce, Bill Brown, and Cindi Beede.

Mrs. Bison convened the meeting at 7:05pm.

1. Caroline Tremblay—Mrs. Tremblay represented the Economic Committee who intend to host a festival on the Common October 6, 2018. The festival will include vendors, craftsmen, and activities. The Economic Committee would like to include town businesses, crafters, and committees. Mrs. Tremblay suggested we discuss the opportunity to be involved. Mrs. Beede stated that October was a busy month for the Recreation Department who host the Spooktacular Fall Fest annually at the end of the month. Mrs. Tremblay stated that she could help man an activity with volunteers if we came up with something and needed help running it. The Recreation Department agreed to brainstorm and check our availability for the weekend of the planned event. Mrs. Beede stated she would keep in touch with Mrs. Tremblay on that status.
2. Kids' Yoga: The first session of Kids' Yoga with Robyn Hannett was cancelled to due weather. The new start date is Friday, January 19th.
3. C/I/T: Caregivers/Infants/Toddlers will begin on Friday, January 12th. It will run for 6 weeks like previous sessions.
4. STRONG by Zumba: A new exercise class taught by Sheena Royce will begin this month. A Free Introductory Class will be held Tuesday, January 23rd from 6:30-7:30 pm at the Samuel E. Paul Community Center in Troy. A Winter Challenge Session is scheduled to follow Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:30-7:30 Jan 30th-Feb 22nd (no class 2/15/18). The cost is \$5/class with a prepaid punch card or \$7/class "drop-in" rate.
5. Basketball: Youth basketball begins this week with practice from 4:30-5:30 on Wednesday and games on Saturday. Mrs. Beede and Mrs. Bison (basketball coordinator's assistant) discussed scheduling before the Commission Meeting.
6. Summer Rec: Mrs. Beede has posted the position of Summer Recreation Director for the 2018 Season. She is working to get an advertisement in the Sentinel, but has already used social media and has one application in hand. She plans to post job openings for counselors at a later date.
